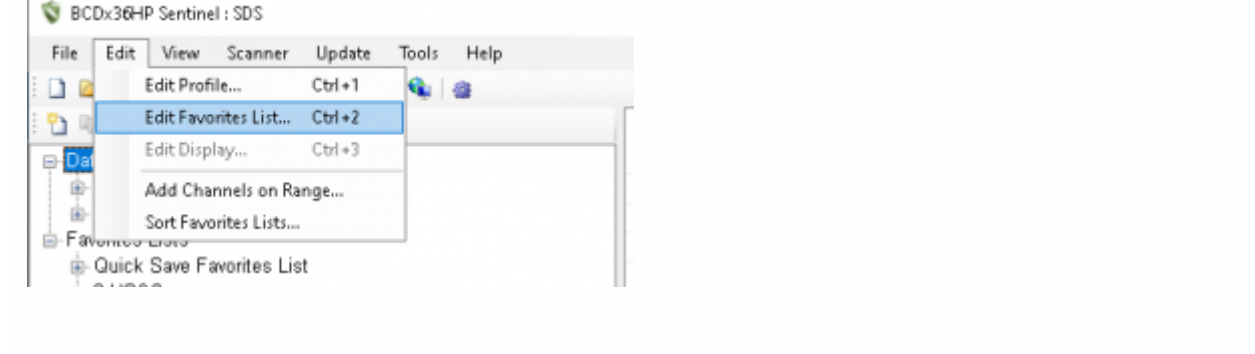

When I create a new favorites list, I don't any way to manually type new frequencies into it.

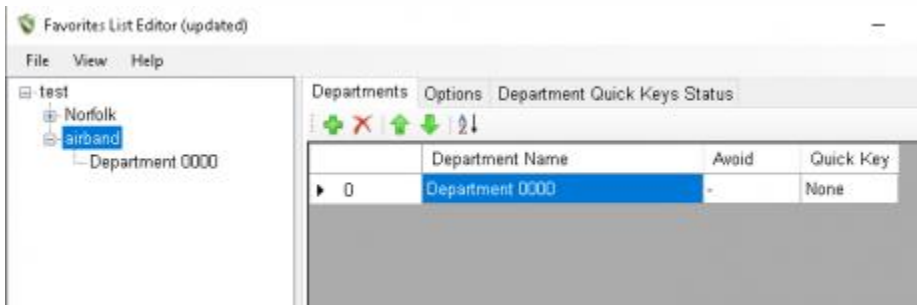

First, read your scanner into Sentinel. To locate the list you want to add to:

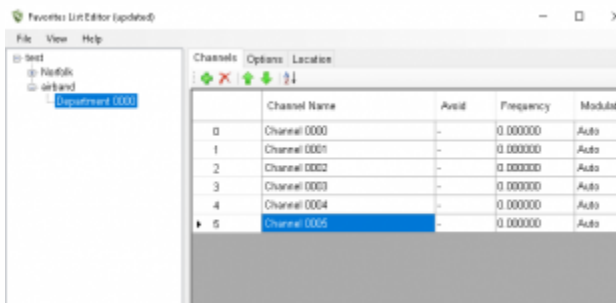


When the new window opens, click green plus sign
