** OKLAHOMA. RF 17, K17JN-D, is still off the air in Enid as in my last report August 12. Now at rabbitears.info I see it listed only as in OKC, site near SE 50th St, on a shared Tyler tower, and not Xed as off the air. So has it really moved permanently? I ask the re webmaster. This leaves Enid without any local TV signal at all. One remains listed in rabbitears.info, K32MG, virtual 19, of Edge Spectrum with grand plans but never seen:

** U S A [and non]. WORLD OF RADIO 2361 monitoring: confirmed Sunday August 23 at 2011 the 2000 on IRRS SW via AM Italia, 1322.994, S9+10 into Parma SDR - which cuts off and on, not the signal.

Also confirmed Sunday August 23 at 2130 on SW Radio Gold, Germany, 6160.001 S9+5 and 3975.002 S9+25 into UTwente.

NOT confirmed Sunday August 23 at 2330 on WRMI 9455, because it's OFF the air - and still off all evening, e.g. at 0453 while the three sevens remained on.

Confirmed UT Monday August 24 at 0030 on WRMI 7780, S9+10/20 into Georgia SDR.

Also confirmed UT Monday August 24 at 0259 on WBCQ 5130-, chopped at 0300 for sign-off, while continues on Area 51 webcast. Next:

** U S A. 5850, UT Mon Aug 24 at 0644, WRMI discussion in English,
presumably DW via WRN as sked, rather than 'Legends' which intruded 24
hours earlier instead of WOR (Glenn Hauser, OK, WOR)

** U S A. 7505, Aug 24 at 0451, S9+30 of deadair from WRNO (Glenn
Hauser, OK, WOR)

** U S A. 15555 USB, Aug 24 at 1454, WJHR preacher at S9, so not off
the air. Strangely, this is much stronger than GB Martí on 13570,
13720 (Glenn Hauser, OK, WOR)

** U S A. 1020 kHz, Aug 24 at 0501 UT, Spanish under KOKP nearby Perry
OK, ID by SHVA for ``99.5 FM y 1020 AM...`` That fits for KMMQ
Plattsmouth NE, U4 50/1.4 kW with translator K258DC, address in Omaha,
site in Iowa. Night pattern major lobe west, notch to SW.

** U S A. 1320 kHz, Aug 24 at 0501 UT, ``Newstalk 1320 .. KWHN``, i.e.
Fort Smith AR, U2 5/5 kW. Site is not in OK, night pattern major lobe
SW, notch to the NW, but apparently enough WNW thisaway:

** U S A. 1320 kHz, Aug 24 at 0517 UT ``Black Information Network`` so

must be KXYZ Houston TX, U4 8400/2800 watts (Glenn Hauser, OK, WOR)

** U S A. 1560, Aug 24 at 0518 UT, guy discussing maladies in Vietglish, rather amusing, from KGOW, Bellaire = Houston TX, U4 46/15 kW, always audible at night tho most signal oppositely into the GoMex. Does Gow mean something in Vietnamese? It's Gow Media, but which came first? (Glenn Hauser, OK, WOR)

** U S A [and non]. 1570, Aug 24 at 0458 UT, Bott network, no XERF; but by 0519 can hear Spanish on N/S antenna, Bott on E/W, i.e. KBCV, Hollister MO = Springfield, U4 5/3 kW. Night pattern NW/SE with a notch toward Del Rio, but evidently enough tisaway westward from site SW of Branson:
